

Your referral to Texas Children's Hospital: Psychology



Your doctor has referred your child for a consultation with a pediatric psychologist at Texas Children's Hospital. Our referral staff will review the information sent to determine what services are most likely to benefit your child and family. They take extra care to match your family's needs with the type of provider who can best help. You may be asked to share additional information via questionnaires to assist us with making this decision. When the review is complete, we will contact you to schedule an appointment. For your convenience, our psychology providers **may offer video visits for certain conditions**.

Where applicable, additional information such as school testing results (e.g., Admission Review and Dismissal report, Full and Individual Evaluation report, dyslexia evaluation report, speech therapy reports, etc.) and divorce decrees must be provided before an appointment can be scheduled.

Please note that there are limited psychology services at some of our community locations.
